INTRODUCTION

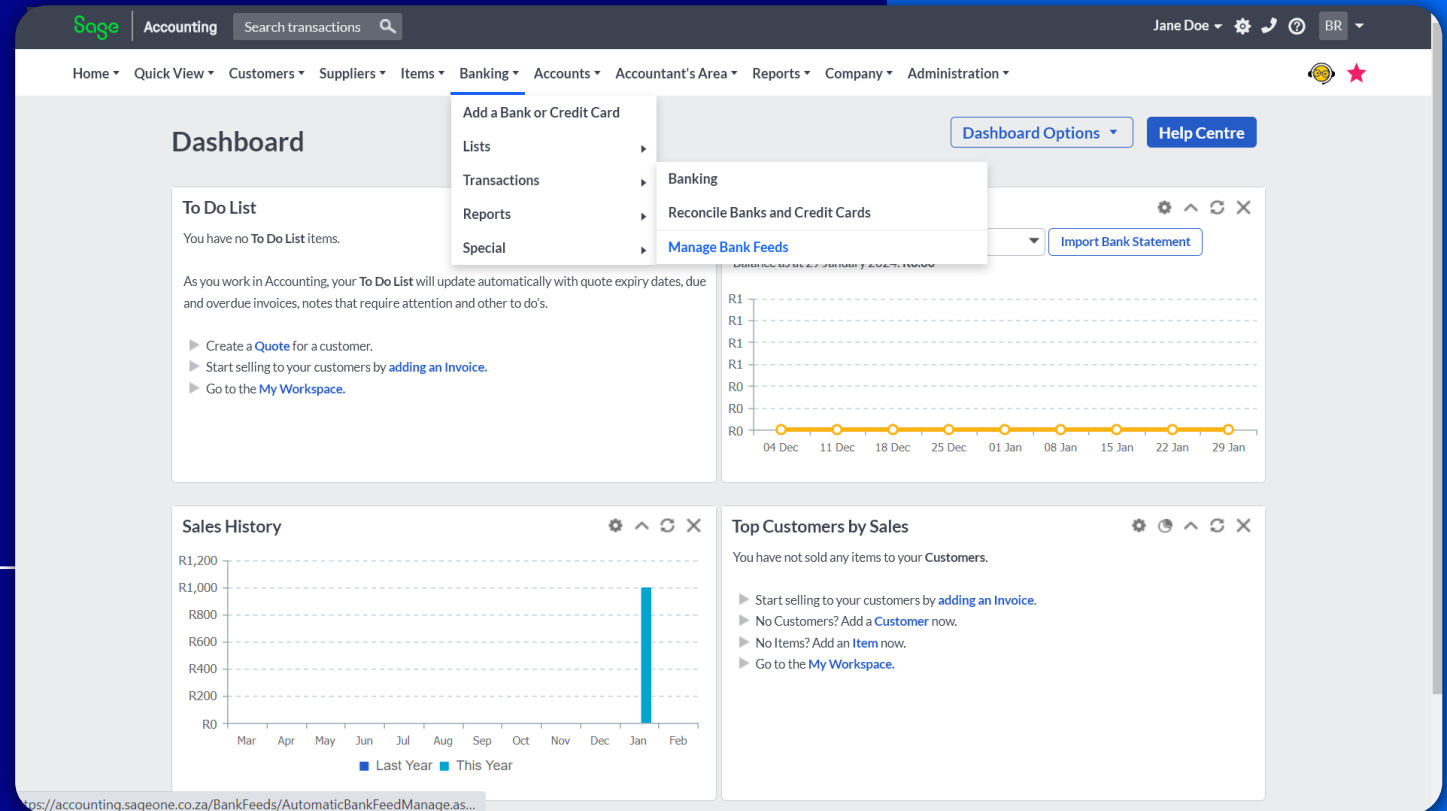
Business customers can now seamlessly connect their Standard Bank transactional account to automatically transfer their transaction history into the Sage Accounting software, thereby eliminating the need for manual data entries whilst enhancing the data security of their banking profile.



GETTING STARTED

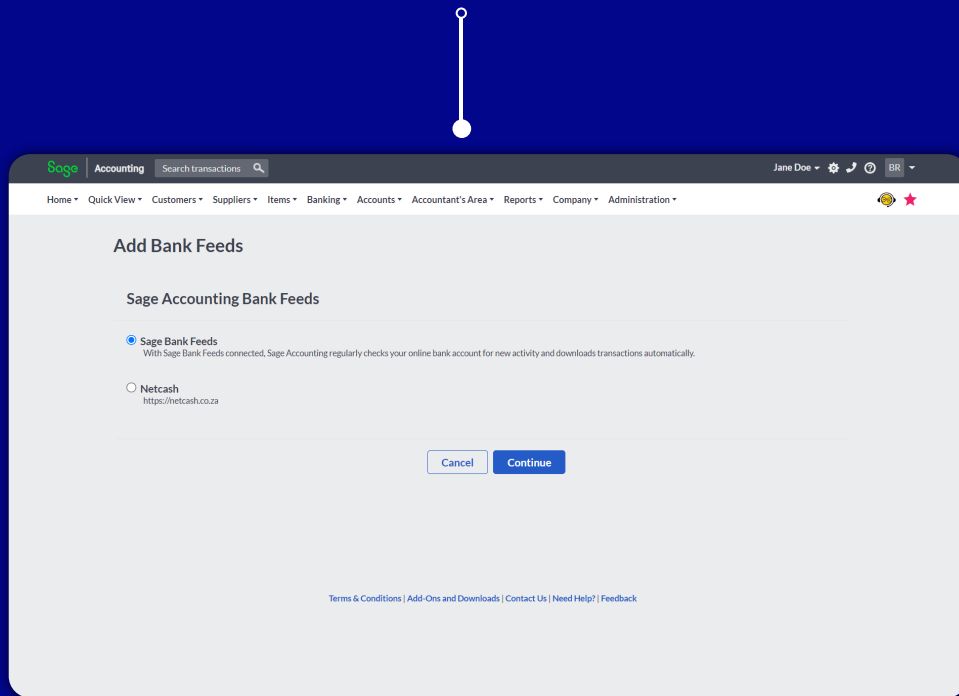
Step 1

To add Standard Bank Direct Bank Feeds, log onto the **Sage Accounting** platform and go to **Banking > Transactions > Manage Bank Feeds**



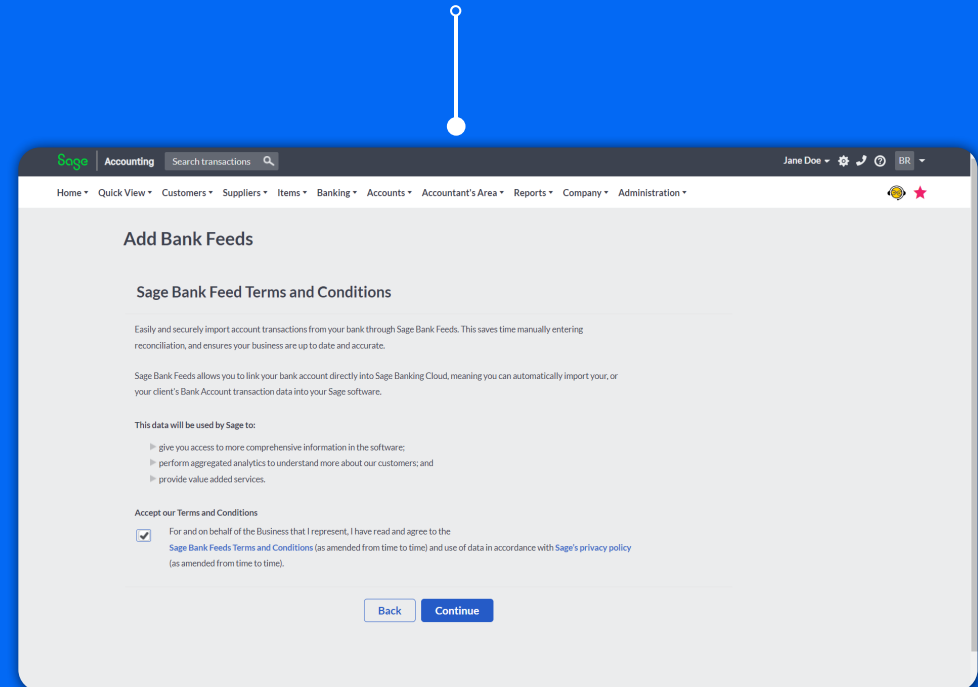
Step 2

Select Sage Bank Feeds and click “**Continue**”.



Step 3

Accept the Sage Bank Feeds Terms and Conditions and click on “**Continue**”.



Step 4

Search for “**Standard Bank**” and click on the search result.

What's needed to connect?


- Have your sign-in credentials on hand for when you're asked to sign into your bank.
Note: For security reasons, you'll be periodically prompted to sign into your bank account.
- Be prepared to enter the start date for downloading transactions. Some banks limit this start date to the last 90 days.

Fill in the required information to connect the Standard Bank account to Sage, then **click “Continue”** to be redirected to Standard Bank for authentication.


Account Number *

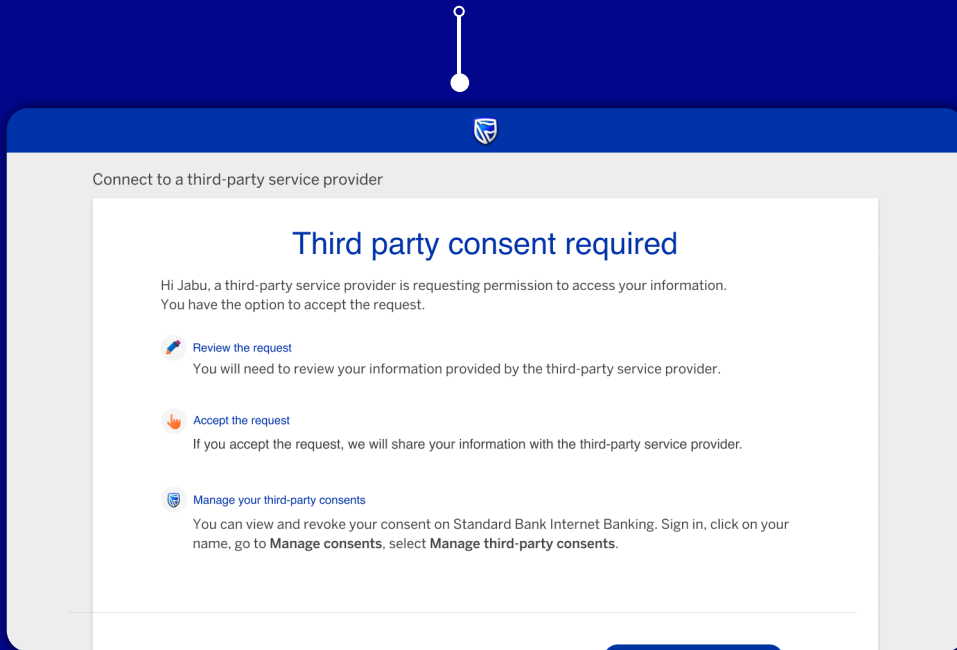

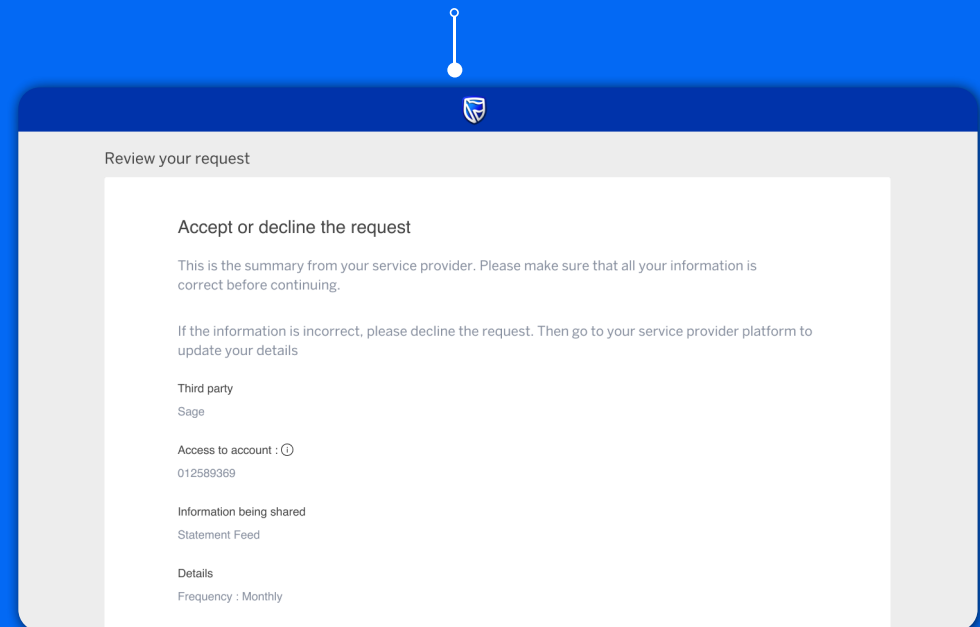
Step 8

Review steps to give consent for Standard Bank to share your account transaction history with Sage and click **“Get Started”**.



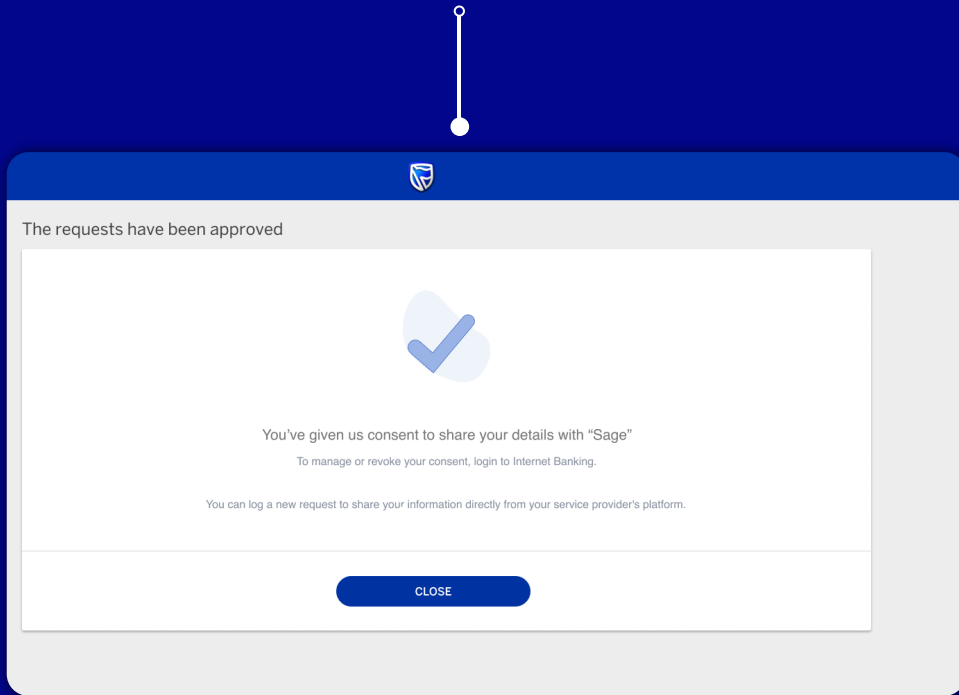
Step 9

Review the third-party access request details **(request to provide consent)** to the third-party **(Sage)**, accept the third-party access **(consent)** Terms & Conditions and click **“Accept”**.



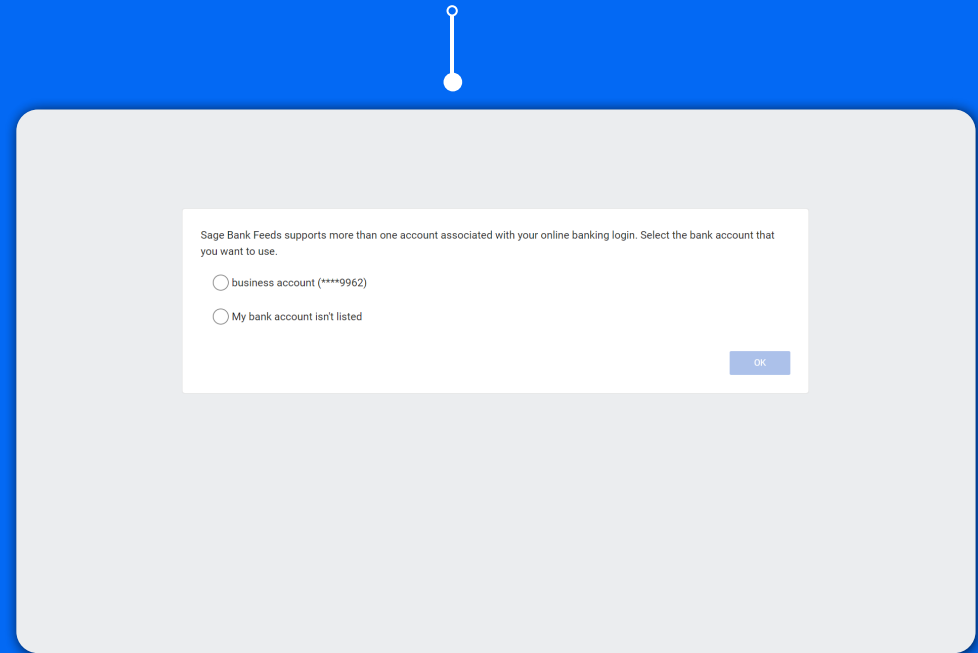
Step 10

Complete Standard Bank consent provision, then click **“Close”** to be redirected back to Sage




Step 11

Complete the Bank Feeds set-up by selecting the account to be linked to the Standard Bank Feed and click **“Continue”**



Step 12

Select the start date for downloading transaction data from your Standard Bank account, and click **“Continue”**.



Step 13

Enter the Sage Accounting Bank Account that will be linked to your Standard Bank Transactional Account.

If you already have a bank account set up in your Sage Business Cloud Accounting, choose **‘Existing Bank Account,’** select from the dropdown menu, and then click **‘Save’**.
